RE: Community Advisory Panel Meeting Minutes for Lake Success Business Park, May 14, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by Tom Stillely, Vice President, Sporting Goods Properties, Inc., and there were 25 people attending. All participants were welcomed and the agenda was discussed.

Roadway-Tracer Brook Remediation and Restoration

Remediation

- Excavated approximately 20,000 c.y. of soil and sediment; the material was managed on-site
- Treated over 1MM gallons of water for lead and arsenic; water was then discharged back into the Brook
- Over 18,000 contractor work hours were performed safely

Restoration

- Restored over 9,000 linear feet of stream embankment with coir logs, coir blocks and rip rap
- Restored 2+ acres of wetlands along with adjacent upland floodplain areas
- Plantings: >500 trees, >700 shrubs, >4,500 live stakes, >2,500 herbaceous plugs

Success Lake Remediation Project

Timeline

- Site preparation: August 2018 through November 2018
- Mobilization: April 1, 2019
- Equipment mobilization/set-up: April 1 through May 31, 2019
- Stormwater management: May 1, 2019 onward
- Sediment Excavation: May 7, 2019 onward
- Munitions separation and management: June 14, 2019 onward
- Water treatment (set-up and operational): June 14, 2019 onward
- Restoration: 2020

August 2018 Munitions Removal

- Found near the shoreline after lowering the water level
- 40 pieces were collected, stored in licensed storage magazine and detonated at the end of December 2018
- The recovered projectiles: 75mm, 57mm and 37mm

Site Preparation Activities

- August 2018 through November 2018, resuming in April 2019
- Limited tree clearing
- Grading and base preparation
- Bypass piping

Corporate Update

- DuPont and Dow announced the intent to merge in December 2015, for the purpose of creating three separate companies: an agricultural products company, a specialty products company and a material science company
- The Dow-DuPont merger was approved and completed on September 1, 2017
- The three companies will separate and become independent in 2019
- Dow was established on April 1, 2019
- DuPont and Corteva will be established on June 1, 2019
- There will changes to our corporate name, but it does not change our clean-up program
- Tom Stilley will still be managing the program
- Sporting Goods Properties, Inc. will remain as the site owner and will continue to fulfill the Consent Order that is in place
- As of June 1, 2019, the corporate “parent” of Sporting Goods Properties, Inc. will be Corteva
